Young Adult Journey Group is an anchor for young adults as they seek to live out their faith in a culture that is ever changing, being reminded they are not alone.



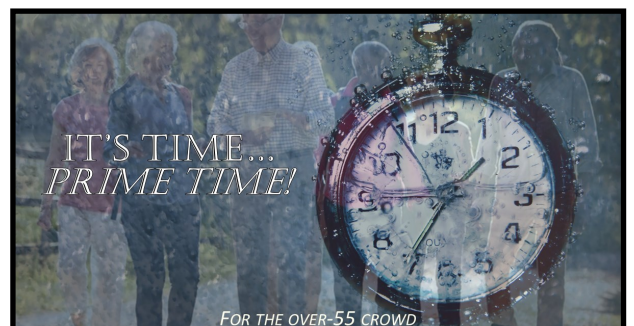
Men's Fellowship enables men to be Men of God boldly at work, at home, and in the world around them through the study of God's Word and providing models of faith to follow.
