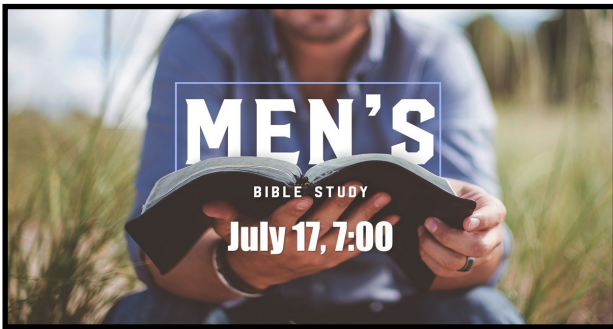
UPCOMING EVENTS

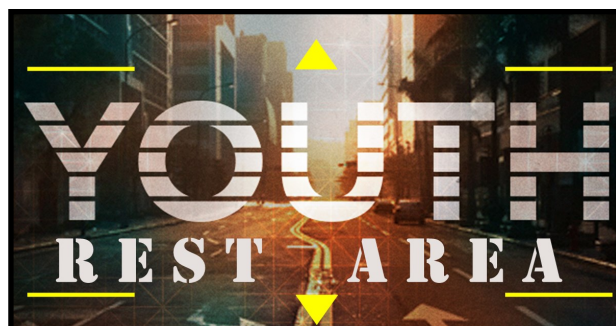
Journey kids is a fun way for children to come to know God and His love for them and to know His Word, in a fun and safe environment.
